SUBJECT: Application Procedures for C-130 Pilot Training

1. Thank you for expressing interest in flying C-130s for the Montana Air National Guard! The 120th Airlift Wing attempts to provide an equal opportunity for all qualified individuals desiring to become a pilot in our organization.
2. Pilot application procedures need to be followed very closely to ensure a complete package is available to the selection board. Please note that the process is lengthy. Any deviations could prevent meeting established time line and result in being eliminated from further consideration. **The deadline for receipt of pilot applications is 30 June 2014.**
3. The initial application must include the following items in a 6 part folder in the designated sections:
(other documents will be discarded before the selection board review process):

Section 1: Full length color photo -- list height and weight on back

Section 2: Personal letter of introduction with goals and Resume (colleges attended, major, GPA, military Experience and flight experience must be included)

Section 3: College transcript – a copy is acceptable
Documentation of military experience - if applicable

Section 4: Documentation of flight experience to include licenses and/or log book entries

Section 5: Air Force Officer Qualification Test (AFOQT) scores and TBAS Scores

Section 6: Letters of recommendation -- limit of 2

4. The minimum prerequisites for application are a bachelor's degree completed by 30 June 2014. Additionally the applicant must meet the attached weight standards and cannot be over 30 years of age by date entering training.
5. Personal interviews will be scheduled ONLY for those applicants selected by the screening board. Due to the reality that some applicants have easier access to the squadron than others, we discourage personal visits to prevent complaints of unfair bias in selecting the most qualified nominee. No other *personal interviews or visits will be accepted*. It is our preference that your application be the best it can be, and if selected for an interview, please use that opportunity to express your dreams, desires, and motivations to be a member of the Montana Air National Guard.
