

## What to expect flying military air

The flexible design of the C-130 enables it to be configured for many different missions, allowing one aircraft to perform the role of many. Much of the special mission equipment added to the Hercules is removable, allowing the aircraft to return to its cargo delivery role if desired. Additionally, the C-130 can be rapidly reconfigured for the various types of cargo such as palletized equipment, floor-loaded material, airdrop platforms, container delivery system bundles, vehicles and personnel or aeromedical evacuation.

### **C-130 Amenities/Facilities:**

- Carry-on baggage will be accessible and stowed under your seat
- Checked baggage will be tied down to the aircraft floor or stacked on a pallet with other bags
- Passenger seating is cargo net style webbing
- Appropriate attire and closed-toe shoes are required
- Hearing protection is needed at all times during the flight, it will get loud, foam ear plugs will be provided, recommend bringing ear defenders or noise cancelling headphones
- Temperature in the cargo compartment can fluctuate drastically & blankets are not provided, please plan accordingly
- Water is available for passenger use, however snacks are not, passengers can bring food on the C-130
- Urinal and chemical disposal toilet (fold-down, bucket-style with a curtain)
